

DISMANTLING SEGURIDAD EXPO 2019

IMPORTANT

REMOVAL OF MERCHANDISE AND STANDS DISMANTLING

In visitor opening hours and for safety reasons, elements and products can ONLY be removed by hand on August 29th from 18:30 until 20:30. The dismantling of stands, removal of exhibited products and others can be removed on August 30th from 09:00 until 20:00 hours and on August 31st from 09:00 until 18:00 hours in continuous opening hours.

We request that you carry out all coordination efforts in order to meet the required deadlines.

The commitments adopted by the Organization Committee with the fairground make it necessary for us to insist on the same, assuming that any exhibitor who has not picked up materials after the deadlines and schedules indicated, has abandoned them and therefore the Organization Committee will proceed to remove the same and use them for whatever purposes it sees fit, invoicing the exhibitor for any expenses involved in the same.

We request exhibitors to remain alert during dismantling so as to avoid any loss. It is NOT recommended to leave isolated products in the stand area.

The organization will NOT be held responsible for potential losses which occur during the period of dismantling.

REMOVAL OF GOODS AND DISMANTLED ELEMENTS

For removal of goods, equipment, exhibition products and materials, the **internal guide** with which these items were checked in should be presented.

If you do not have this document you can request and complete a new internal exit guide which will be authorized by the pavilion manager. This guide should be supported by a copy or photocopy of the corresponding dispatch guide.

In the case of equipment or goods with temporal admission, these should be supported by a copy or photocopy of the admission plus the letter from the Customs Agency authorizing the change of address.

It is responsibility of each exhibitor company to remove the remaining material, debris and waste due to works construction and stand assembly. The work area should remain always clear and clean.
